*A **Tumbling Class** is highly recommended. We will have a group class arranged at Tumbling 4 Cheerleading Association in Mokena. This cost is not covered in the above St. Al's fees. A 6 week session costs \$78, we may have them at their facility or at St. Al's.

Representations and Contract Agreement:

Parent(s) and Player(s) each represent the contract agreement as follows:

1. Eligibility Policy:

Player is a registered St. Al's student

2. Good Standing Policy:

Family of the Player is in "good standing," which means the family (i) registered as parishioners at St. Al's, (ii) attends mass at St. Al's regularly, (iii) through the envelope system or otherwise contribute a minimum of \$500 per year to the parish collection. The good standing requirement is a continuing covenant to be maintained at all times.

3. Notice of Registration:

Family of Player and Player has each received, reviewed, and understands the Notice of Registration provided at registration, and acknowledges that information and policies provided herein and therein have been (i) mandated by the Pastor, (ii) are general in nature, (iii) are not intended to cover every aspect of the program but rather to give a general outline, and (iv) remain subject to change at any time.

4. Commitment & Attendance:

- Cheerleading is a unique sport that is a very team-oriented. Each cheerleader plays a specific and important role in which other cheerleaders depend upon her. An individual cheerleader's absence will affect the entire team. Each cheerleader being on time and present at practices directly affects the safety and progression of the team's abilities.
- Full attendance at all choreography, camps, games, events, and competition is necessary.

- Vacation or days missed must be communicated to the coaches at least 2 weeks prior of the actual vacation and may not be during a scheduled competition or camp.

5. Cheerleader's Conduct Responsibilities:

Cheerleaders are reminded that at any time they are in their St. Al's uniform, they are representing themselves, their team, and the entire St. Alexander Parish. Cheerleaders are expected to behave and display positive and appropriate conduct at all times. St. Al's cheerleaders should strive to be leaders within the school and model good examples for other students at all times. Respectful interaction with teammates, parents, coaches, and teachers is required. This includes, but is not limited to actions, words, attitude and social media posts.

6. Parent Involvement:

- We ask that parents monitor your student's grades, injuries and sicknesses.
- Respect the team season schedule, and your student's commitment to the team and payment due dates.
- Display respectful and positive interaction with coaches and other parents
- Support your cheerleader at scheduled events
- Chaperone and volunteer to assist at events

7. Safety & Stunting

- Nails must be trimmed, smooth, and not exceed the fingertip. NO NAIL POLISH for competition
- Hair is required to be in a high ponytail at all cheerleading activities, unless otherwise advised by the coaches
- Stunting may only be performed under the supervision of a coach or clinic professional
- It is a cheerleader's responsibility to use caution when executing skills during the cheerleading season. A cheerleader is permitted to execute only those skills she can safely perform.
