## **GENERAL INFORMATION 2023-2024**

# **HOURS**

The entry bell rings at 7:45 a.m. School begins at 8:00 a.m. with dismissal at 2:40 p.m. for full day Kindergarten and grades 1-8. Morning Kindergarten hours are 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

## **EXTENDED DAY PROGRAM**

The Extended Day hours are 2:40 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The program is available on all full days of school and some 1:30 p.m. dismissal days. St. Alexander students in PreK through grade 8 are welcome to register. There are registration and hourly fees for this service. Morning care is also available at 7:00 a.m. Students must be walked into school.

## PRE-KINDERGARTEN PROGRAM

PreK students must be 3 or 4 years of age by September 1<sup>st</sup> and self-sufficient in the restroom. Full-day enrollment is available, starting at 8:00 a.m. with dismissal at 2:30 p.m. Half-day enrollment is available, starting at 8:00 a.m. with dismissal at 11:00 a.m. The following options are available:

- 3-year-olds and 4-years-olds
  - o 3 days per week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday)
  - 5 days a week (Monday through Friday)

#### LUNCH

FSA runs weekly Fun Lunch/Hot Lunch specials through outside vendors.

### **UNIFORMS**

Schoolbelles is our school uniform distributor. Our school uniform may be purchased through their catalogue. Uniforms are to be worn every day, beginning with the first day of school, unless announced otherwise. Examples of school-approved footwear can be found in the St. Alexander School Handbook.



<u>GIRLS</u>: Grades K-3 wear a green plaid jumper, white blouse with round collar, and white or navy solid color socks (covering the ankle) or tights. A navy cardigan, v-neck sweater/vest or approved Spiritwear sweater may also be worn over the uniform. Navy slacks may be worn instead of a jumper in cold weather. Navy walking shorts may be worn until October 1<sup>st</sup> and after April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Grades 4-8 wear a green plaid skirt or skort, navy ribbed bottom polo, and white or navy solid color socks (covering the ankle) or tights. A navy cardigan, v-neck sweater/vest or approved Spiritwear sweater may also be worn over the uniform. Navy slacks may be worn instead of a skirt in cold weather. Navy walking shorts may be worn until October 1<sup>st</sup> and after April 1<sup>st</sup>.

<u>BOYS</u>: Grades K-8 wear navy trousers, light blue polo, and white or navy solid color socks (covering the ankle). A navy cardigan, v-neck sweater/vest or approved Spiritwear sweater may also be worn over the uniform. Navy walking shorts may be worn until October 1<sup>st</sup> and after April 1<sup>st</sup>.

<u>GYM</u>: Gym uniforms can be purchased through our Family School Association (FSA). Students are permitted to wear:

- St. Alexander gym shorts or sweatpants
- St. Alexander gym t-shirt or gym approved Spiritwear t-shirt
- white crew socks (socks must cover the ankle)
- black or white gym shoes, properly laced and tied

Students are permitted to wear their St. Alexander gym uniform all day in school on their gym days, including their day of Mass attendance.

## TUITION/FEES - PRE-KINDERGARTEN

The nonrefundable PreK registration fee is \$50 per student. There is an additional \$75 per student supply fee for PreK.

Following is the annual Preschool tuition schedule for the 2022-23 school year.

## **TUITION/FEES – KINDERGARTEN – GRADE 8**

The nonrefundable K-8 registration fee is \$100 per family.

Following is the annual K-8 tuition schedule for the 2022-23 school year. There are two payment options: pay the full annual amount or pay in ten-month increments using the FACTS payment plan. If the full annual amount is selected, there is a \$50 credit on the full tuition amount\* and the \$35 FACTS enrollment fee is waived, but payment must be made by July 15. If the ten-month schedule is selected, the two payment schedule options are July 1st through April 1st or July 15th through April 15th.

The last payment billed will be adjusted to reflect the annual amount stated above.

Payments should be made monthly. Any late fees or nonsufficient check fees will be determined by FACTS.

All tuition must be paid by May 1, 2024. Tuition payments made after May 1, 2024 must be paid in cash, money order or cashiers check – no personal checks will be accepted.

All out-of-parish families or families not fulfilling their covenant commitment will pay an additional \$1,700 per family in addition to the above tuition.

#### **FUNDRAISING COMMITMENT**

- Family with one child \$300
- Family with two children \$400
- Family with three or more children \$500

## **TEXTBOOKS/TECHNOLOGY FEE**

There is a \$150 nonrefundable book fee per student in grades K-8. There is a \$100 nonrefundable technology fee for students in grades 3-8.

## **HEALTH AND DENTAL REQUIREMENTS**

PreK – physical examination within 12 months of entering Preschool and current immunization record

Kindergarten – physical, dental and vision exam forms with doctor's written signature

1st Grade (new students only) – vision exam form with doctor's written signature

2nd Grade – dental exam form with doctor's written signature

6th Grade – physical and dental exam forms with doctor's written signature
